When I think of the early years when I was cutting my teeth as a preacher, his smiling face surfaces in my memory. He endured and kept bringing his family back for more. What a godly man.

Decades later I was introduced to another in a long line of godly men that had crossed my path as a pastor. He smiled from ear to ear and spoke with gentle encouragement. He seemed almost too kind to be genuine. The passing of the years revealed him to be absolutely authentic in the love he evidenced. Every time I visited with him he said many things positive.

You can understand my amazement one afternoon when a conversation turned toward high school sports. My smiling Christian brother with whom I currently serve confessed that he and my Christian brother from the first church where I preached were both ejected from a basketball game in which they were competing against one another. In the heat of the moment they lost a bit of self control and were sent to the showers. No specifics were given. No specifics were needed.
